Historic company breaks ground at Business Park

PARK'S GREEN APPLE HONOUR

Birmingham Business Park has won an International Green Apple Environment Award in the campaign to find the greenest companies and organisations. The Business Park competed against more than 500 nominations in the International Green Apple Awards 2019 and will be presented with a trophy and certificate at a glittering ceremony in the Houses of Parliament, London, on November 25, 2019. As a result of the International Green Apple Award success, Birmingham Business Park has been invited to achieve Green World Ambassador status and have its winning paper published in The Green Book; the leading international work of reference on environmental best practice.



After more than 100 years at the famous Camp Hill site, Sulzer has started the process to move its facilities and create a new centre of excellence for its customers.

Sulzer's brand-new service centre will be located at the prestigious Birmingham Business Park, where the company will base its UK head office as well as state-of-the-art repair and maintenance facilities.

The 7618 sq. m (82'000 sq. feet) purpose-built service centre has been designed using 3D mapping technology that positions both the existing and new equipment in the most efficient layout. By optimizing the floor plan, material flow will be improved and project repair times for customers will be minimized.

With the official ground-breaking ceremony completed the build phase is very much underway.

Project Manager, Warren Bell, said: "It's great to see the plans become reality, it's all starting to become very real now.

The foundations are in place for the main steel uprights to go in and shape the building, and the cavity for the overspeed pit is almost finished. Exciting times are ahead".

The building phase is scheduled to be complete in early May 2020, after which there will be a carefully planned relocation of all

the equipment. In addition to the existing equipment, Sulzer is also taking the opportunity to invest in a new high-speed balancing chamber, which will be located below-ground, and will be one of the most advanced facilities in Europe.

A large factor in the decision to move to the site was the services that Birmingham Business Park offer. Kevin Smith, Human Resources Manager, said: "The amenities and social culture on the business park are a huge plus, and we are working to communicate these benefits to our employees. We are very much looking forward to being a part of the community."

HIGH-SPEC GRANITE 40 TAKING SHAPE

A digital impression of the new site

BlackRock, in conjunction with Development Manager Canmoor, are on site constructing a speculative industrial/warehouse building of approximately 40,000 sq ft. The building, which sits on the same plot at the new Sulzer facility, is being constructed to a high specification with its location close to the entrance to Birmingham Business Park.

Granite 40, as the building will be marketed, will benefit from 10m clear internal height to the warehouse/production space, 2 dock level loading doors, 2 level access loading doors, a 45m yard and 62 car parking spaces (with electric charging points). Internally the 4,000 sq ft of offices will be completed to a high specification and will benefit from LED lighting, a metal suspended ceiling and full raised access floor.

Rolls-Royce Control Systems (RRCS) is a supply chain unit within Rolls-Royce Civil Aerospace, specialising in the design and manufacture of safety critical electronic and mechanical components for the aerospace industry.

The company and its predecessors have been in the business of designing, developing, manufacturing and procuring engine controls systems and components for aircraft turbine engines since the technology was developed in the 1940s.

The business possesses unique expertise and its highly skilled, dedicated workforce is a key asset which enables Rolls-Royce to stay ahead of the international competition. RRCS's technology and capability in high integrity control systems and solutions is applicable to a variety of other demanding environments expanding beyond aerospace, such as electric motor control systems



for marine and aerospace applications. In order to support the company's ambition to improve performance, Rolls-Royce invested £75 million in a purpose built state-of-the-art manufacturing and technology facility at Birmingham Business Park, to consolidate its activities in the Midlands. RRCS employs 2000 people world-wide of whom 1200 are based at Birmingham Business Park.

The Derwent building (named after Rolls-Royce's first Jet engine), opened in 2016 and provides facilities for the manufacture of electronic and mechanical products alongside engineering test capabilities, office accommodation and employee welfare facilities. The

building occupies 17.5 acres of a 24-acre site, and has 28,000sq m of floor space. The remainder of the plot has been acquired by Rolls-Royce to enable future investment.

Stuart Baker, Operations Planning Executive for RRCS, who managed the investment to create the building, says: "We set out to create a working environment that retains, attracts, supports and inspires our people to produce the best work of their lives.

"Location was important to us – we could design our own building, but we needed the location to support our objectives too and Birmingham Business Park has lived up to our ambitions."
